SUBJECT: Implementation of Revenue Requirement, Rate and Tariff Changes associated with BVES General Rate Case, in Accordance with Decision No. ("D") 14-11-002.

PURPOSE

In compliance with California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") Decision (D.) 14-11-002, Ordering Paragraph No. 1, Golden State Water Company ("GSWC") on behalf of its Bear Valley Electric Service Division ("BVES") submits Advice Letter 308-E. The purpose of this Advice Letter is to comply and make effective the rates approved by the Commission for 2016.

BACKGROUND

In D.14-11-002, Ordering Paragraph No. 1, the Commission approved the Uncontested Settlement ("Settlement") filed by GSWC on behalf of BVES, the Office of Ratepayer Advocates ("ORA"), the City of Big Bear Lake, Big Bear Area Regional Wastewater Agency, and Snow Summit, Inc.

The Settlement authorizes BVES to recover the Base Rate Revenue Requirements for 2016 in the amount of \$20,900,000 as shown in the Table below.

TIER DESIGNATION

In D. 14-11-002, Conclusion of Law, Paragraph 10.3, the Commission authorizes that "BVES should file a Tier 1 AL by December 1, 2015 in order to make all preliminary statements, rate and tariff changes authorized herein for 2016".

EFFECTIVE DATE

GSWC respectfully request this Advice Letter become effective January 1, 2016. No individuals or utilities have requested notification of filing of tariffs. Distribution of this Advice Letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with General Order No. 96-B.

NOTICE AND PROTESTS

A protest is a document objecting to the granting in whole or in part of the authority sought in this advice letter.

A response is a document that does not object to the authority sought, but nevertheless presents information that the party tendering the response believes would be useful to the CPUC in acting on the request.

A protest must be mailed within 20 days of the date the CPUC accepts the advice letter for filing. The Calendar is available on the CPUC's website at www.cpuc.ca.gov.

A protest must state the facts constituting the grounds for the protest, the effect that approval of the advice letter might have on the protestant, and the reasons the protestant believes the advice letter, or a part of it, is not justified. If the protest requests an evidentiary hearing, the protest must state the facts the protestant would present at an evidentiary hearing to support its request for whole or partial denial of the advice letter. The utility must respond to a protest with five days.
